




GREEN SPACES WITHIN SHEFFIELD

- A great way to spend your free time is by getting to know the many green spaces and parks within Sheffield
- Sheffield has **80 public parks** and 650 other green and open spaces, making the city a greener, cleaner and more attractive place to live, work and visit.





- The largest park within Sheffield is Graves Park, located in the southwest of the city.
- The park provides the following facilities – a café, 2 children's playgrounds, animal farm, sporting facilities: Bowling Green, Cricket, Football, Tennis, 9 Hole Pitch & Putt nature trails, fishing lake, woodland and plenty of open space.
- Allowing for a mix of activities to do whilst enjoying the outdoor space





THEATRES

- Sheffield has four great theatres Crucible, Lyceum, Merlin and Montgomery.
- The Crucible hosts the annual world snooker championship
- At Christmas time many theatres in England put on a a pantomime, a musical comedy based on traditional fairy tales







ENGLISH INSTITUTE OF SPORT

- The venue is home to a number of local and national sporting clubs including GB Boxing, England Boxing, British Wheelchair Basketball, British Para Table Tennis, Badminton England and British Ice Skating.
- The world class facilities are past and present training ground for world champions such as Jessica Ennis-Hill, Anthony Joshua, Nick Matthew and Will Bayley.
- Specialist facilities include 2 multi-purpose sports halls, table tennis hall, netball hall, basketball hall, spin studio and a 200m Indoor Athletics Arena.
- The EISS includes a Fitness Unlimited gym and offers several classes, coached lessons and other activities.
