Spanish Courses for Erasmus and International Students

- Intensive Online Course: REQUIRED if you can't certify A1 level of Spanish
- Intensive Course (Face-to-face): Levels A1 and A2 40 hours that can be recognized by 5 ECTS
- Regular Courses: 50-hour course. 6 ECTS credits.
- Fall Semester: September to December.
- Spring Semester: February to May.

Medical Insurance	
Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, United Kingdom, Switzerland and EU nationals	Students coming from the countries mentioned are entitled to the same public healthcare services as the residents of the country they are visiting. They should apply for the European Health Insurance Card at the local social security or sickness insurance office in their home countries.
Other countries	Before coming to Spain, citizens from other countries must get private medical insurance covering medical assistance and hospitalisation, including repatriation cover that will cover expenses incurred abroad. It is the students' responsibility to check with their Insurance Company at home that they have adequate insurance cover for their full period of study in Spain and to get familiar in advance with policy conditions.
