INTRODUCTION

Programme Overview

The Foundation in Arts programme at IUMW acts as a prerequisite for students who intend to pursue their degree within the fields of arts, humanities, business, law, social sciences, and information technology. Students gain the knowledge to be able to think independently and creatively, communicate their knowledge effectively with others, operate in a constructive, ethical and professional manner, and boost their proficiency in the English language.

A solid foundation programme can give students an advantage over others who are entering higher education directly after high school. Using tertiary-style teaching with plenty of lectures, tutorials, and seminar-type classes, students are able to kick-start their undergraduate endeavours on a firm platform. With IUMW, you will find yourself academically ready and personally confident enough to succeed at your chosen undergraduate course.

INTAKE

January, May, Sept

Students are expected to undergo three (3) semesters which amounts to 51 credit hours to complete their study.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- *O Level Grade C in any five (5) subjects*
- *UEC Grade B in three (3) subjects*
- *IB-Middle Year Programme 28 total points across the certificate's 7 components*
- *Other qualifications recognised as equivalent*

ASSESSMENT

Assessments under the Foundation in Arts are varied, and are either based on; full coursework (100%) or a combination of coursework (40 – 60%) and final exam (40 – 60%). Classes are held face-to-face through lectures, tutorials (offline and online), discussions, activities (classroom-based or outside-classroom-based). Our students are expected to demonstrate their understanding through several forms of assessment, including but not limited to; examinations, quizzes, reports, projects, and presentations.

Total Fees: RM18,350 (including registration, administration, & tuition fees)

- Registration Fees: RM600
- Administration Fees: RM5,000

Visa Application Fees / EMGS Fees: RM2,700

For living expenses, a budget of **RM2000 per month** would be comfortable for the student which would include accommodation, transport, telecommunication and personal expenses

Total for 1-year expenses = **RM 45,050 per year** (taking the highest end)

English 1

Seeks to develop and enhance student's overall proficiency by integrating the three skills of reading, writing and speaking through the covering of the fundamentals of English history and grammar components. The completion of a variety of written and oral-related tasks are designed to develop their perceptive and critical communicative skills using English Language. This module will provide the students with enriching experiences and useful course skills in their tertiary education.

English 2

Covers the fundamentals of English Language as used in different community (spoken) and in academic (written) setting. It increases their overall English Language proficiency and their specific knowledge of community (spoken) and academic specific (written) language. It will

give students more confidence beyond their foundation program as this module is to build the confidence needed for entering undergraduate and programme beyond level 3. Language-based activities such as writing and speaking are essential and they will provide students with enriching experiences and useful undergraduate study language skills through this module.
