Language of Instruction	All courses taught in English unless students enroll in an upper-level Spanish or French, or introductory German course.
English Language Requirements (TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo or other)	Compulsory; Minimum of 79 on IBT TOEFL is required; <i>Letter from outbound exchange coordinator or faculty stating English proficiency satisfies the language requirement.</i>
Level/Courses/Programs offered for incoming students	Undergraduate/Bachelor
Course Selection/Procedure	After admission, students must submit a course preference form with general areas of interest. Students will receive access to OASIS after their admission and are expected to review course listings in OASIS to complete the course preference form.
Course Information/Syllabus	Course schedules will be created after the course preference form is submitted. Course schedules can be changed through the end of the first week of classes.
Course load per semester	Minimum enrollment of 12 credit hours and maximum 16 credits.

Requirements for Exchange Students		
Visa (F-1)	Detailed visa information/ guidance is emailed after acceptance with the issuance of an I-20 form.	
Health Insurance	Purchasing health insurance is the responsibility of the student and is required for university attendance. Students have the option to purchase an insurance plan upon arrival to the U.S. if they have not purchased coverage at home.	
Accommodation	Housing on campus is required in one of our upperclassmen dorms. Most exchange students are placed in Jobe-Hansen or Bowden-Magbee which offer single room capacity housing and allow students to live in apartment style housing.
