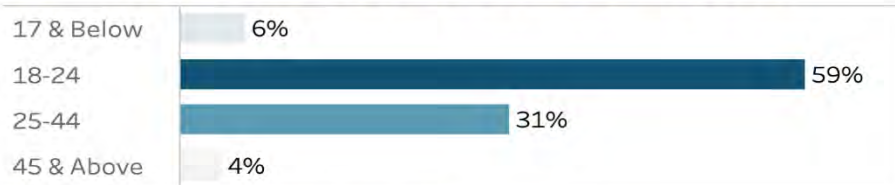

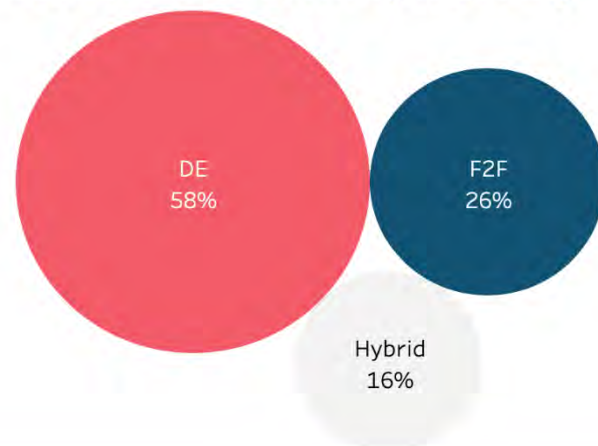
Our most populous age group is 18-24 years.

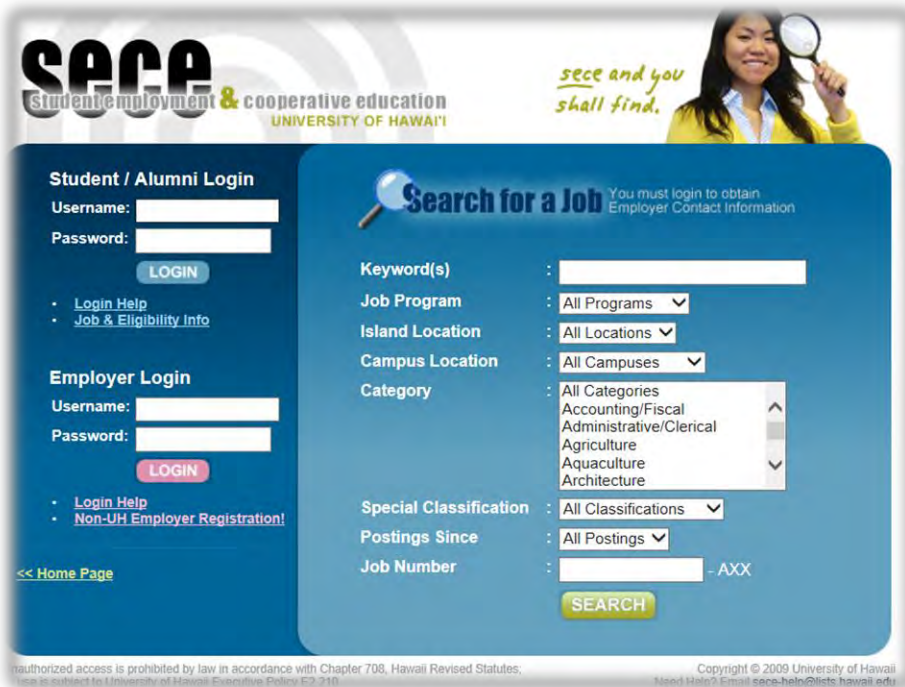

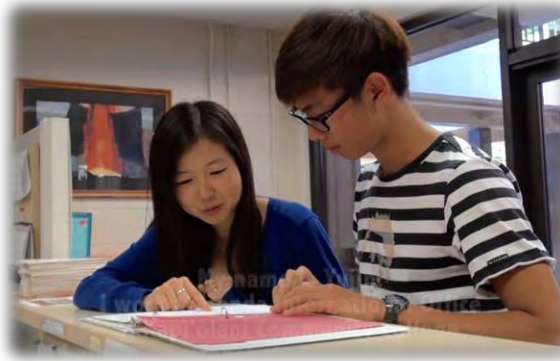

- OPT is a 12 month practical training opportunity provided by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).

Eligibility Requirements for OPT?

- Students MUST have been in lawful F-1 student status for at least 1 full academic year and graduating from a Certificate of Achievement program (1 year) or an Associates Degree (2 year)
- Employment must be directly related to the student's major
